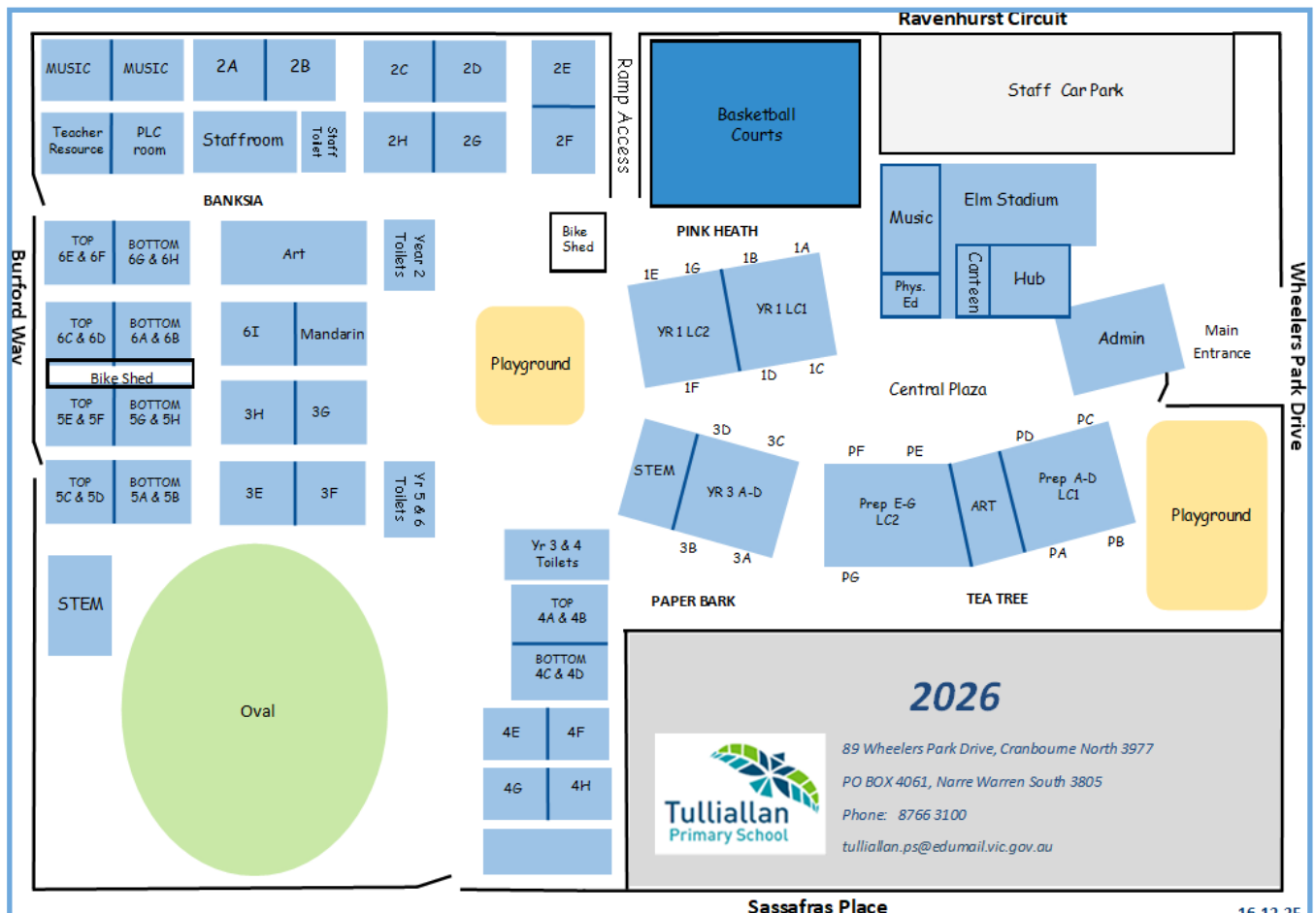

# ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

## UPDATED DEPARTMENT POLICIES

### SCHOOL INSURANCE:

**REMINDER** – the Department (which includes our school) does not have personal accident insurance for students. If a student is injured at school or while participating in a school activity (including offsite) and requires medical treatment, parents/carers are responsible for all of their child's medical expenses.

This includes transport costs such as ambulance costs (which may include an air ambulance if considered necessary)

**REMINDER** – the Department (which includes our school) does not have personal property insurance for staff and/or students. Items of personal property that are lost, stolen or damaged at school or during school excursions are not the responsibility of Tulliallan Primary School or the Department.

Staff and students are reminded not to bring items of value to school or on school excursions.

Tulliallan Primary School encourages parents/carers to consider obtaining their own accident insurance for students and property of value that may be brought to school.

### BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL YARD DUTY SUPERVISION:

Student safety at Tulliallan Primary School is our highest priority and the safe and appropriate supervision of students is an important element of our duty of care to students.

Part of this duty is ensuring parents and students are aware of our student supervision arrangements before and after school.

Tulliallan Primary School's entry gates are supervised by school staff from 8.35am until 8.50am and 3.10pm until 3.25pm. Parents enter the school site and drop students at their appropriate Home Group door.

All students when entering the school go directly inside to be supervised.  
At the end of the school day, students are to directly exit via a school gate.

Students on school grounds outside these times will not be supervised (unless they are attending a before or after school care program or supervised extracurricular activity).

Parents/Carers are requested to ensure that students do not attend school outside of these supervised times unless they are attending before or after school care, or a pre-arranged supervised activity (i.e. sports practice).

If you have any concerns about child safety at any time, please contact the school.

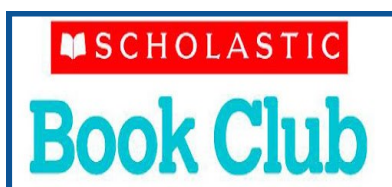

### **What is the Walking School Bus?**

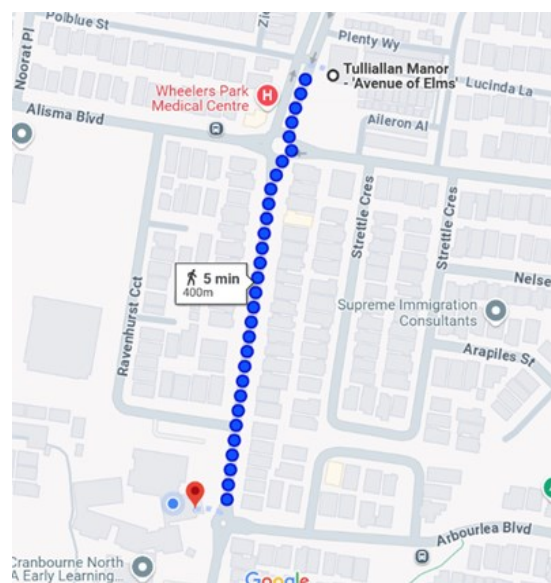
