PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

WELCOME BACK

I would like to welcome back all of our students, parents and staff to what is likely to be another busy and enjoyable school term. I hope that everyone had a wonderful and safe Easter break spending quality time with family. I welcome the new families that have joined our school this term and know they will love being a part of the Tulliallan family in no time. It was lovely in the yard on Monday hearing the students talking about how they were happy to be back at school.

SCHOOL WORKS OVER THE HOLIDAY BREAK

We were fortunate to complete a few projects on the holidays to improve our school. In the Prep play area we have installed a section of synthetic turf to provide an all weather surface. We have widened the path from the Blue Playground to the portable areas to support the large amount of foot traffic that uses this path. We have had extensive cleaning across the school and the installation of three AC units to the portable STEM, ART and Sassafrass rooms.

The COLA cover is nearly ready to handover to the school so that we can begin to use our basketball courts again for lessons and play.

Unfortunately, further work was needed for our oval to repair the grass surface. This has meant part of the oval cannot be used, to support the repair. As we are a Public Private Partnership (PPP) school, Downer runs all of the facility management meaning that even though we are consulted, some priority works must be undertaken for repair that may affect school use.

ANZAC DAY CEREMONY

On Monday we held our ANZAC Ceremony. School Captains, House Captains, Art, Stem and SRC Student Leaders conducted the ANZAC Day Service for our students, staff and parents. Thanks to the community for supporting this event. The students were exemplary in their presentation to the assembly, on the significance that Rosemary and Poppies play alongside the history of ANZAC Day.

This service along with classroom learning tasks, provides our children with information and a better understanding of our nation's involvement in wars over the years in our quest for democracy, freedom and peace for all Australians and our allied nations. We hope students came home on Monday and shared what they learned with families. Our school wreath was laid at the Berwick cenotaph ready for the Friday service.

A big thanks to the choir who performed on the day, our music team for the last post and Ms Cooper, Mrs Lodewyke and Mr Tong for their preparation of the students for the service.

The Prep, Year One and Two students had a lovely time showing their creations at the Easter Hat Parade on the last day of Term One. Thank you to our families who were a fantastic audience cheering and clapping supporting the students, especially the Preps for their first school Easter parade. BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL YARD DUTY SUPERVISION

Student safety at Tulliallan Primary School is our highest priority, and the safe and appropriate supervision of students is an important element of our duty of care to students. Part of this duty is ensuring parents and students are aware of our student supervision arrangements before and after school.

Tulliallan Primary School's entry gates are supervised by school staff from **8.35am until 8.50am** and **3.10pm until 3.25pm**. Parents enter the school site and drop students at their appropriate Home Group door.

All students when entering the school go directly inside to be supervised. At the end of the school day, students are to directly exit via a school gate.

Students on school grounds outside these times will not be supervised (unless they are attending a before or after school care program or supervised extracurricular activity). Parents/carers are requested to ensure that students do not attend school outside of these supervised times unless they are attending before or after school care, or a pre-arranged supervised activity (i.e. sports practice). SMALL GROUP LEARNING

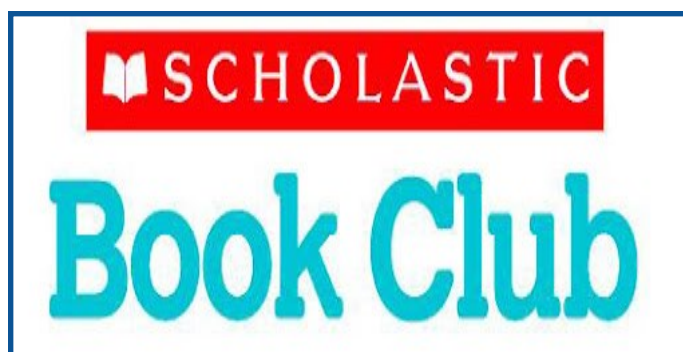

All members of the Tulliallan Primary School community (Students, Families/Carers and Staff) are invited to take part in our weekly Walking School Bus Program.

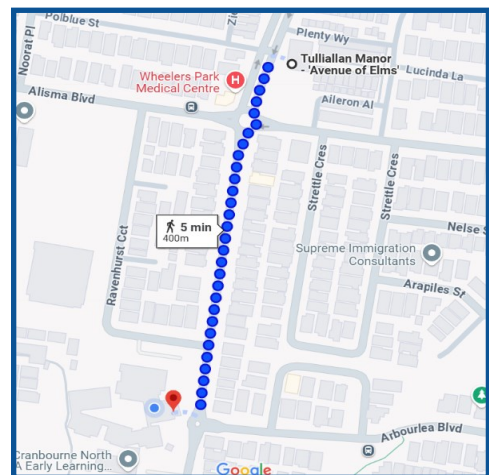
