ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL YARD DUTY SUPERVISION

Student safety at Tulliallan Primary School is our highest priority, and the safe and appropriate supervision of students is an important element of our duty of care to students. Part of this duty is ensuring parents and students are aware of our student supervision arrangements before and after school.

Tulliallan Primary School's entry gates are supervised by school staff from 8.35am until 8.50am and 3.10pm until 3.25pm. Parents enter the school site and drop students at their appropriate Home Group door. All students when entering the school go directly inside to be supervised. At the end of the school day, students are to directly exit via a school gate. Students on school grounds outside these times will not be supervised (unless they are attending a before or after school care program or supervised extracurricular activity).

Parents/carers are requested to ensure that students do not attend school outside of these supervised times unless they are attending before or after school care, or a pre-arranged supervised activity (i.e. sports practise).
